RACE OVERVIEW: No absolute superstar two year old this year, but that means have a good, competitive Golden Slipper. I have Tagaloa on top – his Blue Diamond win was huge, then he had a lovely tune up for this in the Todman. He'll be close enough in the run from his draw and should be in the finish. Farnan has a foolproof racing style and has to be a chance, my only query on him is that his two best runs have been on softer ground than this. I'm a huge fan of Minhaaj as a horse, but she's been a big shortener during the week. If she'd drawn a gate and had a big-race jockey on board I'd have her top pick, but the map looks a bit awkward and the value isn't really there now (no surprise to see her overcome the negatives and win, however). Best roughies for me are Prague on the quick back up, and the untapped Hungry Heart.
