RACE OVERVIEW: No real speed here and a few jockeys will have decisions to make early in the race – I've mapped Sherwood Forest wide but he could well roll forward. Shadow Hero the obvious top pick again but I think the price is short enough this time. Castelvechio's best ever run was at this trip for this jockey when second in the Cox Plate last year, so he can be expected to improve – again, he's around the right price in my opinion. I'm interested in the two New Zealanders (Sherwood Forest and Scorpz) at a bit of a price – the NZ 3yo form is very strong this year and they can run well at odds. Warning is ticking over very nicely as well, but expect to be at his absolute top in the Derby and/or Sydney Cup.
